Pascal Jolivet Sancerre Blanc 2007/8 ~ Loire £ 28.50

Pascal is highly regarded around the world for the quality of his gastronomic wines ~ an intense but beautifully balanced Sancerre which expresses the flint and chalk minerality of the small select vineyards.

Blanc de Blanc Clos Mireille Domaines Ott 2007 ~ Provence £ 29.50

Grown on the edge of the Mediterranean ~ a stunning fresh blend of Semillon and Rolle ~ citrus flavours balanced with good minerality

Beaune Blanc, Domaine des Clos 2005 ~ Burgundy £ 37.50

Bright and fruity, featuring spring blossom, citrus and apricot notes matched to a fleshy texture and balanced oak. Beautifully balanced

Rouge

Pascal Jolivet Sancerre Rouge ~ Loire £ 32.50

100% Pinot Noir ~ an elegant red with developed aromas of red fruit and subtle spicy flavours.

Beaune Premier Cru 'Champs Pimonts', Domaine des Clos 2005 ~ Burgundy £ 39.50

A deep rich and sumptuous vintage from this superb 1er Cru vineyard

Chateau Batailley ~ Pauillac 5ème Cru Classé 2002 ~ Bordeaux £ 42.00

Fantastic nose of blackcurrant with a touch of lemon-grass and cherry ~ the palate exudes class with its smooth tannins and integrated oak.

Château D'Angludet Cru Bourgeois Cantenac ~ Margaux 2001 ~ Bordeaux £ 44.00

Purple and very clear with a fully developed fruit driven nose. Rich, delicate Margaux fruit with a hint of chocolate—not overly concentrated. Approaching full maturity.

Nuits-St-Georges 1er Cru 'Les Pruliers', Domaine Taupenot-Merme 2000 ~ Burgundy £ 65.00

A superbly developed Burgundy ~ a touch of wood spice adds interest to the deep blue fruit and violet aromas that are balanced by classic old Burgundy animale character ~ the fine textured palate possesses excellent depth and length on the balanced finish.

Chateau Trotte Vieille 1er Grand Cru Classe 2000 ~ Bordeaux £ 95.00

The nose has a fantastic herbaceous character with notes of mushroom ~ stewed red fruit leads to a beautiful undertone of dark plum and blackcurrant, topped of with some elegant vanilla. Hints of classic pencil shavings are also there.

Bordeaux and the South West

Domaine de Ricaud ~ Entre Deux Mers

Classic Bordeaux Blanc ~ fresh fruity nose with a crisp dry palate. The freshness of Sauvignon Blanc and the roundness of Sémillon - a perfect combination.

Bourgogne Aligoté, Domaine Manants, Jean-Marc Brocard

A clean fresh wine made from the second grape variety of Burgundy.

Château Puy Blanquet ~ Grand Cru St Emilion 2002 £ 27.50
A deep red coloured wine with abundant red fruit aromas and flavours. Great body from the Merlot with supple, silky tannins on the finish ~ a very serious St Emilion
